Bunu alıyorum.

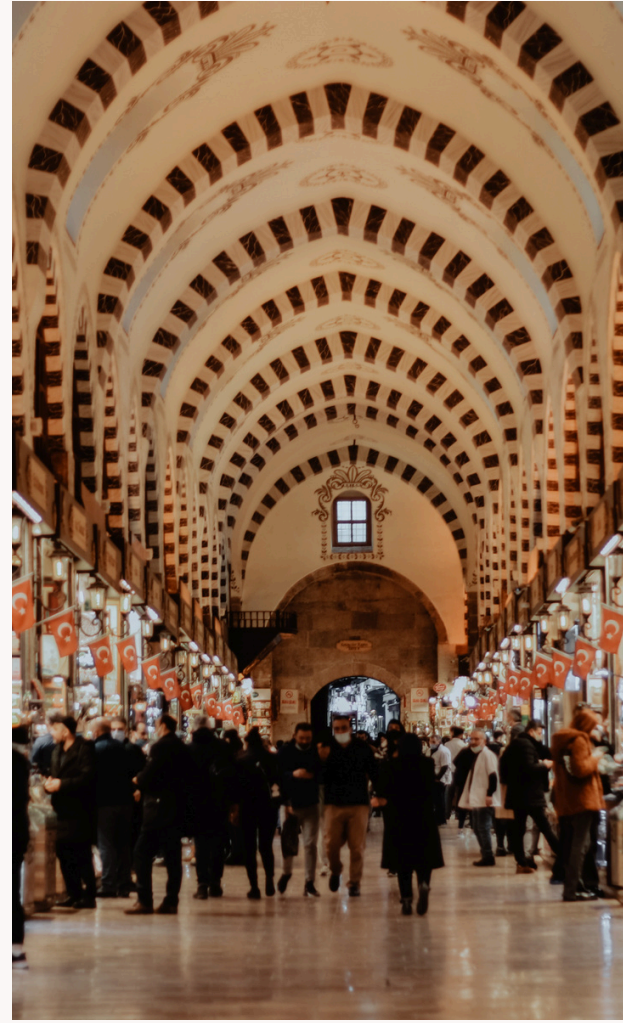
📌 Example Dialogue in a Store:

👤 Customer: Bu çanta ne kadar? (How much is this bag?)

👤 Seller: 200 lira ama size 180 olur. (It's 200 lira, but for you, 180.)

👤 Customer: İndirim yapabilir misiniz? (Can you give a discount?)

👤 Seller: Tamam, 170 olur! (Okay, 170!)
